Upper Foundation Stage visit to Wigfield Farm

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to inform you that we have arranged an educational visit for the children in Upper Foundation to visit Wigfield Farm near Barnsley. This facility is operated by Barnsley College and the children will enjoy a tour around the farm and have the opportunity to visit the reptile room (which is normally closed to the public) whilst we are visiting.

We are planning to visit Wigfield Farm on: **Tuesday 2nd July 2024.** We will leave school shortly after the children have arrived and been registered and will return to school in time for the end of the school day (traffic permitting).

The children can choose to have a packed lunch provided by school, or can bring their own packed lunch from home. The school lunch will consist of a choice of sandwich (ham, cheese or tuna), vegetable sticks, fruit and a muffin.

If you would like your child to have a packed lunch provided, you will be able to order through the school app and the link will follow this letter. Please note any school provided packed lunch must be ordered by 11.00am Friday 21st June.

If you are providing your child with a lunch from home, please can these be placed in a named carrier bag so that these can all be disposed of at the farm (no plastic lunch boxes and metal spoons).

All children will need to bring their named water bottles to drink from at lunchtime and throughout the day.

Children need to be dressed in school uniform with appropriate footwear for a day out on the farm (no sandals please). Please ensure your child brings a sun hat to school and also a coat, as we know the British weather can be unpredictable! Please apply suncream to your child **before** they come to school.

If your child has any animal allergies that we need to be aware of, please speak to your child's class teacher/key worker as soon as possible.

The trip will cost £6.30 for each child, which includes coach travel and entry to the farm.

Our trip has been generously subsidised by the Friends of Holy Trinity who have made a generous contribution to the cost of the coaches. Payment needs to be made via ParentPay by Friday 21st June. You will receive an additional letter to enable you to activate this account, if your child did not attend Lower Foundation.
