EARLY YEARS PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING

When your child began attending their early years setting, you completed a Parent Agreement Form. You included information on this form to enable us to carry out an Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) eligibility check. I am pleased to inform you that you have met the criteria which entitles your early years provider to receive an additional EYPP payment for your child.

EYPP payments are an additional payment made directly to your early years provider for any child who meets the EYPP eligibility criteria. The payment will be used by your early years provider to support the improvement in education and attainment for your child. Your early years provider will receive this funding until your child attends full time schooling where you will then be invited to apply for the full-time Pupil Premium Funding.

This payment does not affect your child's entitlement to the early years free entitlement or any benefits which you may personally receive.

If you have any questions relating to the Early Years Pupil Premium, please discuss this in the first instance with your early years provider who may contact Wakefield Council for further information and advice.
