This Curriculum Information document details our curriculum coverage for this half term.

This half term the Year 5/6 topic is **Benin** and much of the curriculum will be taught through this context.

Reading

Developing reading skills is one of the most important things your child can do at this stage in their life. We teach reading every day in school and have daily opportunities to read for pleasure. Children have a school reading book in class, which they will bring home; they should aim to change this regularly. Children are required to read every evening for at least 10 minutes and have their reading record signed.

Writing

In English we will be using a range of text-types to learn about applying punctuation correctly, using clauses correctly to form different types of sentences, strategies for accurate spelling, developing handwriting and using exciting vocabulary. Year 6 children will also be developing their grammar, punctuation and spelling skills.

Maths

This half term the children will be focussing on statistics, shape and angles. It is essential that all children are fully confident with all of their times tables. Please ensure they are spending time on TT rockstars at home. 10 minutes every day would be fantastic.
