

Year 1/2 Curriculum Information

Summer 2 2025/26



This Curriculum Information document details our curriculum coverage for this half term.

This half term the Year 1/2 topic is **You Wouldn't Want to Be a Victorian!** and much of the curriculum will be taught through this context.

Reading

Developing reading skills is one of the most important things for your child at this stage. In school, we teach reading every day and make time to enjoy books together. Your child will have a school reading book that they will bring home and should aim to change regularly. We ask that children read for at least 10 minutes each evening and have their reading record signed. Most children will also have a Read Write Inc. book to practise their sounds, which should be brought to school each day. Most children in Year 2 will be in the Fluency group and will bring home a book to enjoy reading for pleasure. In addition, all children will choose a library book to share and enjoy at home. Please take time to listen to your child read and ask a few questions about the story to help check their understanding.

Writing

In English, our first focus text this half term is Storm Whale. We will be consolidating the skills we have learnt through this text. We'll also be writing a recount of our school trip to Filey. We will be developing more independence and using a variety of skills. Finally, we will write a letter to our new teacher! We will continue to focus on developing neat handwriting and using different spelling strategies throughout the half term.

Maths

This half term the children will revisit and consolidate our understanding of place value and four operations. We will continue learning about measure, including mass, capacity and length/height, as well as learning to tell the time and recognise/use money. Please continue to use Times Table Rock Stars to develop your child's speedy recall of their 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.
