

Year 1/2 Curriculum Information

Autumn 1 2026/27



This Curriculum Information document details our curriculum coverage for this half term.

This half term the Year 1/2 topic is **Our Wonderful World!** and much of the curriculum will be taught through this context.

Reading

Developing reading skills is one of the most important things for your child at this stage. In school, we teach reading every day and make time to enjoy books together. Your child will have a school reading book that they will bring home and should aim to change regularly. We ask that children read for at least 10 minutes each evening and have their reading record signed. Most children will also have a Read Write Inc. book to practise their sounds, which should be brought to school each day. Some children in Year 2 will be in the Fluency group and will bring home a book to enjoy reading for pleasure. In addition, all children will choose a library book to share and enjoy at home. Please take time to listen to your child read and ask a few questions about the story to help check their understanding.

Writing

Our focus texts this half term are Rosie's Walk and A Squash and a Squeeze. In Year 1, children will be developing their basic sentence-writing skills, focusing on using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces correctly. In Year 2, children will be developing greater independence in their writing and applying a wider range of skills, including identifying and using nouns and verbs. Across both year groups, we will also be focusing on developing neat, legible handwriting and encouraging children to use a range of spelling strategies to help them spell words independently.

Maths

This half term, the children will develop and embed their understanding of place value, building strong foundations for their mathematical learning, before moving on to addition and subtraction. Year 1 will focus on numbers within 10, while Year 2 will develop their understanding of numbers within 100. We will use lots of practical equipment and hands-on activities to help children develop confidence and deepen their understanding. Please also use Times Table Rock Stars to support your child's speedy recall of their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
