Topic	<p>What makes some places sacred to believers?</p> <p>The Children in KS1 will learn about different places of worship including a church, synagogue and mosque. They will learn about the customs, symbols object and stories related to each place of worship.</p>	<p>Why does Easter matter to Christians?</p> <p>The children in KS1 will learn about the Easter story and why It is such an important festival for Christians.</p>
Know & Do	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that there are special places where people go to worship. • Know what people do at the different places of worship. • Know at least three objects used in worship in two religions and know how they are used. • Know a belief about worship and how this connects to God. • Know stories, objects, symbols and actions used in churches, synagogues/and or mosques. • Know how people worship at church mosque and/or synagogues. • Know why some people like to belong to a sacred building or community. • Know how to ask good questions about what happens in different places of worship. • Know how to explain what they think happened in different places of worship and give good reasons for their ideas. • Know what makes some places special to people. • Know the difference between religious and non-religious special places. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that Christians believe Jesus is God in Human form. • Know the Easter story including, Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. • Know that salvation means to be saved. • Know that Christians believe Jesus saved them when he died on the cross. • Know that Jesus came to Earth to give people instructions about how to behave. • Know three examples of how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus' death and resurrection in church worship (eating hot cross buns, make palm crosses, service at 3 o'clock). • Know how to ask questions about whether the story of Easter has any significance to sadness, hope or heaven. • Know that Easter is very important in the big story of the bible. • Know that Jesus showed that he was willing to forgive all people, even putting him on the cross. • Know that Christians believe Jesus rose from the dead, giving people hope of a new life.

Topic	<p>Who is Jewish and how do they live?</p> <p>The children in KS2 will learn about the way Jewish people live in both Orthodox and Reform communities. They will learn about Shabbat and how this is an important celebration for all Jewish people.</p>
Know & Do	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that Jewish people worship at a synagogue • Know the words of the Shema as the Jewish prayer. • Know the special objects you might find in a Jewish home including mezuzah, candlesticks, challah bread, challah board, challah cover, wine goblet, other kosher food, star of David, prayer books, chanukiah, kippah. • Know that Jewish people celebrate shabbat from sunset on a Friday until sunset on a Saturday. • Know that Jewish people have their day of rest on a Saturday. • Know that most Jewish people visit the synagogue on a Saturday. • Know how Jewish people celebrate Shabbat at home. • Know the simple stories used in Jewish celebration- Chanukah or Sukkot. • Know how to link some of the messages in Chanukah or Sukkot with the way Jewish people live. • Know how the stories used to celebrate Shabbat remind Jews about what God is like- • Know how to make links between Jewish ideas of God and how Jewish people live e.g. • Know that the seventh day of rest is symbolic to the creation story- "On the seventh day God rested" • Know how to ask questions about what Jewish people celebrate and why. • Know how to reflect on their knowledge and talk about why they think Jewish people live this way, giving reasons for their ideas. • Know some stories from the Jewish Bible including The call of Samuel (1 Samuel 3) and David and Goliath (1 Samuel 17).
